"That Waterford City & County Council calls on the Department of Education & Skills and/or Department of Health to introduce a scheme to provide all teachers and Special Needs Assistants [who are physically able] with Occupational First Aid training, encompassing CPR."

"That Leitrim County Council call on the Minister for Health, Simon Harris TD, to intervene in the HSE's decision of not automatically awarding medical cards to cancer patients, and, to issue a directive from Government, to ensure that all patients who receive a cancer diagnosis are awarded a medical card."

"Donegal County Council deplores the slaughter of more than 60 Palestinians and the wounding of thousands of others in Gaza by the Israeli Defence Forces. We call on the government to immediately expel the Israeli ambassador in protest at his massacre of unarmed civilians. We applaud the recent decision of Dublin City council to support the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions movement. We reaffirm our solidarity with the Palestinian people and commit the Council to implementing a policy of Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions against Israel until there is freedom for the Palestinian people. Support the holding of an international enquiry into the killings."
